Leanovations Teaches Lean and Kaizen following these 14 Toyota Principles

1. Base your decisions on a long-term philosophy about customer value
2. Create continuous flow
3. Use "pull" systems where flow is not possible
4. Level out the workload, eliminating overburden to people and equipment
5. Build a culture of stopping to fix problems to get quality right
6. Use stable, repeatable methods – standardize
7. Use simple visual indicators to help people realize when there is a problem
8. Use only reliable, thoroughly tested technology and employ that technology to support people, not replace them
9. Grow leaders from within rather than reaching outside for executives
10. Develop exceptional people and teams that follow your company's philosophy
11. Respect your extended network of partners and suppliers
12. Observe "Go and see" for yourself to thoroughly understand a situation
13. Make decisions slowly, by consensus
14. Become a learning organization through relentless reflection and continuous improvement
